

Spring Fury Elite/Sport Adventure Race Update #2
4/9/08

Greetings Racers!

This is the second update for the 2008 Spring Fury Adventure Race. This is expected to be the final update as well. Both updates are posted on the Spring Fury web page in PDF form: <http://www.infiterrasports.com/08fury.htm>. Please be sure all your teammates have received this as well. This second update only contains the most pertinent information, so be sure to review Update #1 as well.

Please make sure to **print and fill out the waiver** that was attached with this update. It is also available as a PDF on the website listed above. You will need the waiver when you check in on race morning.

The race day timeline is as follows:

Saturday April 12th, 2008

Registration: 5:00am to 6:30am

Race Briefing: 6:45am

Race Start: 8:00am

Race Cutoff: 7:00pm

Post Race Food with Prizes: 7:15pm

Registration/Race Start:

The start and finish will take place at the Long Lake Outdoor Center in Yankee Springs State Park. For a park map visit http://www.michigandnr.com/Publications/PDFS/RecreationCamping/yankee_springs_map.pdf.

You should arrive at check-in by 6:00am at the latest in order to have everyone through registration so the briefing can begin on time. You need to arrive at registration with all your teammates and go through the process together.

If you are bringing your own canoe/kayak, there will be a boat drop. It is not a long distance from the check in location, so just bring it with you on race morning and you will get more information there.

You will need either a day pass or an annual Michigan State Parks sticker for your vehicle. Day passes will be available for \$6 if you are a Michigan Resident or \$8 if you are out of state.

Please be sure that if you are a minor and will be racing that you have a parent or guardian with you. You may also arrange for your parent or guardian to have signed the waiver and then just bring that to the race. To get such a waiver contact Zac@infiterrasports.com.

Post Race Food:

We will have a big post race cookout. Plan to stick around after the race to eat and socialize!

Accommodations:

It is not too late to make reservations to stay at the Long Lake Outdoor Center for this race weekend. But please contact [Luke](mailto:luke@infiterrsports.com) – luke@infiterrsports.com ASAP. There are a handful of cabins still available for Friday night as well as camping and bunk house options. No small cabins are available for Saturday night. Full details on the Long Lake Outdoor Center are available in Update #1 and on the website.

Sponsors at the Race:

Look for key sponsors Salomon, Jeep and Suunto to be out at the race! Be sure to stop by and show your support.

Gear Moving:

Remember, we will be transporting a gear bag with your personal paddles and PFD's at different points throughout the race. You will be able to put additional gear, food, etc. in this gear bag, but they all need to fit in this bag. Your paddles can have the shafts extending out of the bag. Please make sure your gear bag is labeled with your team number. Team numbers have now been assigned. Please see the Team's List at the bottom of this update or the list online to find your team number.

Paddling:

Please check the Team's list to be sure we have your rental equipment correctly assigned. Additional rental canoes are available, but please contact Zac (zac@infiterrsports.com) immediately. Rental fee is \$30 per canoe.

Remember the note from Update #1: Those racers that do have kayak paddles available, we advise you bring them to the race, even if you plan to paddle your canoe with canoe paddles. They will make the second paddling section easier☺

Gear List:

Make sure you have the mandatory gear including the 8"x8" piece of laminating/contact paper for your passport that you must provide. There will be gear checks in the race.

Course Conditions and Weather:

The snow and ice is gone, but unfortunately, it looks like the gorgeous weather from this past weekend will not hold out. The forecast is calling for cool temps in the mid 40's with a chance of showers. Please dress appropriately.
