

So what is a "Passport", "Contact Paper" and why do I need them?

-A passport is your record of the race and how you prove you went to all the points that you went to. It is the most important piece of the race. Passports are provided and given to you at race check in.

-Contact paper is the clear sticky paper you will put on your passport. You must supply your own and it is mandatory. Passport size is ~ 4" x 8".



Note the clean passport on the left, obviously aided by using contact paper, see below, which is MANDATORY GEAR. Punches are very clear and easy to read. On the other hand, see the dirty passport on the right. How many punches did they get, can't quite tell? And they got a 15 minute penalty for not using contact paper. A penalty may also be issued for passport in poor condition. You should keep your passport in a map case during the race and not fold or write on it.
