RACE INSTRUCTIONS

2008 INFITERRA SPORTS RAGE 10HR SPRINT

All CP's (manned & unmanned) will have a flag and punch. For all CP's it is your responsibility to punch your passport in the correct location and keep your passport intact to be turned in at the finish. You will receive multiple passports for different sections of the race. It is your responsibility to maintain them. At manned CP's you also need to check in with race staff so they can record your time.

START – Located at Caberfae Resort. The race will start from the parking lot area. You should be out and ready to race by 8:45am.

BIKE

CP1 – Located in a small depression not shown on your map on the west side of a 4-wheel drive trail.

CP2 – Located in the southwest section of an intersection of a two track and a road.

CP3 – Located on the south side of a road after a large bend near a creek.

CP24 – Located at Walker Bridge Canoe Livery. Here you will have access to your gear bag and you will transition to paddling.

PADDLE

CP25 – Located at an area known as Elm Flats on river right. From your transition at CP24 you will paddle the fast and fun Pine River to CP25. At CP25 you are free to bundle up & label your personal paddles & PFD's to leave at CP25. If you have rented equipment you will leave that as well. All other gear that you will need for the remainder of the race you must be prepared to carry with you as you trek back.

TREK

CP22 – Located on a very large hill/spur overlooking the valley floor. From the paddle takeout at CP25, you must wade the river and trek to CP's 22, 23, 21 and then to CP20, which is back at Walker Bridge and the location of your paddle put in. You should retrieve these CP's in the order listed.

CP23 – Located just east of a two track in a wet ditch near a culvert.

CP21 – Located near the bottom of a steep side hill near the edge of a swampy area.

CP20 – Located at Walker Bridge Canoe Livery. Here you will again have access to your gear bag and you will transition back to biking. When traveling from CP21 to CP20, note the added small black line on your map that represents a foot bridge that we recommend you use on your route back Walker Bridge Canoe Livery

BIKE

CP26 – Located at the intersection of a two track and 4-wheel drive trail.

CP27 – Located at a drainage culvert on the side of a trail. When biking to CP27, you will notice the added black trail going north and then coming back down to the CP location. You will most likely need to follow this trail as you will find some of the others shown on your map do not exist.

CP28 – Located back at Caberfae Resort. Check in with race staff at the Blackmore Lodge. We recommend that from CP27 you bike out to the east and hit the main road to loop around to the north and come into Caberfae.

TREK / O-Course

Control Points **29 - 38** may be obtained in any order. You will use the provided pre-marked Caberfae O-course map for this section and a new passport. To remain a ranked team you only need to get **three** of these points.

CP29 – Flag – Hilltop

CP30 – Flag – Reentrant

CP31 – Flag – Hilltop

CP32 – Flag – Reentrant

CP33 – Flag – Hilltop

CP34 – Flag – Hilltop

CP35 – Flag – Hilltop

CP36 – Flag – Reentrant

CP37 – Flag – Saddle

CP38 – Flag – Hilltop

FINISH – Located back at Caberfae Resort in the Blackmore lodge.

The cutoff time is 7:00pm on Saturday. After that time you will be unranked and should check-in with race officials and make arrangements to return to Caberfae.
