RACE INSTRUCTIONS

2009 SPRING FURY ELITE ADVENTURE RACE

- While biking on roads, stay single file and to the side of the road.
 - You must punch your passport at all CPs, even manned CPs. It is your responsibility to punch your passport in the CORRECT location and keep your passport intact to be turned in at the finish. Remember to cover your passport with protective contact paper as required by the gear list.
 - Make sure to notify race staff if you are leaving the race for any reason.
 - Your vehicle and the parking lot will serve as the TA for this race. You may access all of your gear any time you return to the TA.
 - We will be using our standard Score-O style for the final Orienteering section. Note the number of CPs to be obtained in this section. In accordance with our rules, you will not be beaten by someone with fewer orienteering points than you. The object is to get as many of the points as you can and get to the finish before the cut-off time. Manage your time accordingly.
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START – The race will start at the Boat Launch right where registration took place. All teams will line in canoes in the water starting 10 minutes before 8:00am. At least the stern of every team's boat must be touching the shoreline.

PADDLE – Make sure to use a rental boat unless you brought your own canoe or kayak! These points can be obtained in any order. You must get all 5 of these points.

CP1 – Located on the east shore of a small inlet .

CP2 – Located on the **Water's Edge** just north of Stanley Rd.

CP3 – Located on the **Water's Edge** just south of Mt. Morris Rd.

CP4 – Located on the **Edge** of Gooseneck Peninsula.

CP5 – Located on an old **Boat Launch Ramp** on the western shore. This is a manned CP – your team will need to get o out and get a new map from the staff. Here you will have to find three check points – A, B, & C. All three are mandatory and can be obtained in any order. Note the entire team must travel to the checkpoints.

CP6 – Located back at the **TA**. Don't forget to PUNCH here.

TA 1 – Located back at the Boat Launch/TA.

BIKE – Remember to ride single file on all roads! You may want a pair of trekking shoes in this section. Note that there is a very nice paved rail trail that connects the towns of Columbiaville & Otter Lake. On your map it is simply shown as a rail grade. It is highly recommend you use this trail.

CP7 – Located just **South of the Dam** on west end of the Holloway Reservoir. When approaching the CP from the south from Carr Rd, do not attempt to scale the fence and ride the direct trail to the dam – proceed just a little further west on Carr Rd to the paved dam access road (shown in purple on your map) to reach the CP. You may walk your bike across the dam after punching the CP.

CP8 – Located just **South of the old road bed**.

CP9 – Located at the same point as CP5, on an old **Boat Launch Ramp** on the western shore.

CP10 – Leaving the town of Columbiaville, you will pick up a Rail Trail. CP10 is located just **east of the rail trail** right after crossing the Reservoir. Note the CP IS NOT visible from the trail. You will have dismount your bike and locate it off the trail.

CP11 – Located on the **east side of the rail trail**.

CP12 – Located in a small satellite parking lot on the **North side of Willard Road**.

TREK/ORIENTEERING – You will pick up a supplemental map at this point to use to obtain CP13-16. These CP's are not marked on your USGS map. All of these points are mandatory. Please be courteous of Private Property.

- CP13 – Located just **East of the old rail bed under a power line.**
- CP14 – Located in **East end of a Small Pond.**
- CP15 – Located on **East side of a Small Creek** between two small ponds.
- CP16 – Located on **East edge of a Small Lake.**

BIKE – Remember to check back out when you pick up your bike at CP12.

- CP17 – Located on the edge of a swamp on the private property of 11291 Van Natter Rd. The CP is on the **West side** of the Driveway on the edge of the swamp.
- CP18 – Located in **front of the house** on the private property of 9428 Henderson Rd. The CP is up the big maple tree near the mail box.
- CP19 – Located back at the **Boat Launch/TA.**

TA 2

TREK/ORIENTEERING – These final points can be obtained in any order. You must get **at least 6** of these points to qualify as a ranked team.

- CP20 – Located on the west side of a wet ditch in a **Reentrant.**
- CP21 – Located on a **Sidehill** north of Stanley Rd.
- CP22 – Located on a **Large Hilltop** on a Ridgeline.
- CP23 – Located on the **North Edge of a swamp.**
- CP24 – Located on the base of a **Reentrant.**
- CP25 – Located on a **Large Hilltop.**
- CP26 – Located on the eastern **Tip of a Spur** near a swamp.
- CP27 – Located in a small horseshoe on the **South Side of Hasler Creek.**
- CP28 – Located on the edge of **Sidehill** near Mud Lake.
- CP29 – Located on a **Fenceline** on the edge of a field.
- CP30 – Located in stand of Pines on a **Small Hill.**
- CP31 – Located on a **Fenceline.**
- CP32 – Located on a small **Spur.**
- CP33 – Located on **Spur** overlooking the water.
- CP34 – Located on a **Hilltop.**
- CP35 – Located on the North side of a **Hill.**
- CP36 – Located in a big **Reentrant.**
- CP37 – Located toward the top of a **Reentrant.**
- CP38 – Located on a **Hilltop** overlooking the water.
- CP39 – Located on the Northwest edge of a **Large Hill.**

FINISH – Located back at the Boat Launch where the race started. **The cutoff time is 6pm or 10 hours from the race start. After that time you will be considered unranked. We hope you enjoyed The Fury!**
